BURKS' NOTICE OF INTENT
TO INTRODUCE EVIDENCE OF SEPARATE
CRIMES AT TRIAL

Comes now, the State of Oklahoma, the Plaintiff herein, and gives the Defendant notice this 22nd day of January, 1996, of its intent to offer and introduce evidence of separate crimes, offenses or bad acts, involving said defendant. This evidence may be offered during the course of the State's case in chief, which is set for trial in the District Court of Lincoln County on the 25th day of March, 1996.

Said evidence is expected to be essentially as follows:

That during the commission of the offense set forth in the Information, Joshua Stump also committed an Assault and Battery With a Deadly Weapon (Shotgun), against Hubert Moucha. Mr. Moucha received a serious, life threatening wound to his hand which resulted in the amputation of his right hand.

Exception: Intent, absence of mistake, common plan or scheme
