Results of examination:

The pellets (items F1, F4 and F6) are consistent with #6 size shot.

The bullet (item F3) could neither be identified nor eliminated as having been fired in the revolver (item S2).

The shotshells (items S6 and S7) were fired in the shotgun (item S1).

DESCRIPTION OF EVIDENCE (CONTINUED):

- #S34 One (1) sealed petri dish containing bloodstained cutting from shirt of Anderson.
#S46 One (1) sealed coin envelope containing known bloodstain, Moucka.

ANALYSIS OF EVIDENCE:

Deoxyribonucleic Acid (DNA) was isolated from the above samples except item #S29-4 and was characterized through the polymerase chain reaction (PCR). The following results were obtained:

Based on these results the DNA profiles from #S29-1 (jeans) are consistent with the DNA profiles from #S23-2 (Anderson). The probability of selecting an individual at random from a population having consistent DNA profiles with the DNA profiles from #S29-1 (jeans) is approximately 1 in 4,550 in Caucasians, 1 in 82,927 in Blacks, and 1 in 10,867 in Hispanics.

ANALYSIS OF EVIDENCE (CONTINUED):

The DNA profiles from #S29-2, #S29-3 and #S29-5 (stains from jeans) appear to be a mixture. The sources of #S23-2 (Anderson) and #S46 (Moucka) cannot be excluded as contributors to this mixture.

The DNA profiles from #S34 are inconclusive; however, the source of #S46 (Moucka) can be excluded as a potential donor of the DNA detected.

Due to the small quantity of sample present in #S29-4 (stains from jeans), no analysis was performed on that item.
