BILL OF PARTICULARS
REQUEST FOR IMPOSITION OF THE DEATH PENALTY

COMES now MILES C. ZIMMERMAN, the duly and regularly elected, qualified and acting District Attorney for the Twenty-third Judicial District of the State of Oklahoma, Lincoln County Division, and does upon his oath as District Attorney give this Court to know and be informed that the crime of Murder in the First Degree, as charged in the Amended Felony Information on file herein, was committed by the said Joshua Daniel Stump, named therein, and that the said Joshua Daniel Stump should be punished by DEATH due to and as a result of the following aggravating circumstances, to-wit:

1. The murder of the said Kathrina Knight was especially heinous, atrocious and cruel in that the said Kathrina Knight sustained wounds inflicted by blasts from a .12 gauge shotgun which wounds did not result in her instantaneous death and that the said Kathrina Knight languished and suffered from

said wounds before losing consciousness and ultimately dying therefrom;

2. The Defendant, Joshua Daniel Stump, knowingly created a great risk of death to more than one person, in that the Defendant not only killed the said Kathrina Knight, but seriously wounded Hubert Moucha by shooting him and causing the ultimate amputation of his hand and further that the Defendant, Joshua Daniel Stump's accomplice, Robert Anderson, was shot and killed during the hold-up attempt as a direct result of the risk created by the Defendant Joshua Daniel Stump, and

3. That due to the past history of the Defendant coupled with his complete lack of remorse for this crime, there exists a probability that the Defendant will commit criminal acts of violence that will constitute a continuing threat to society.


